- * Full Paper (2000–3000 words): The manuscript should be in MS Word (.docx/.doc format), Times New Roman (English), Kalpurush (Bengali) having abstract, keywords and endnote referencing (APA Style – 7th Edition). Please attach a similarity test report along with the full paper.
- * The paper presenter and participants will be issued certificates.
- * Presenter(s) can present his/her paper in Bengali, English.
- * We have a plan to publish the selected papers as edited volume with a reputed publisher.
