Topics Discussed:

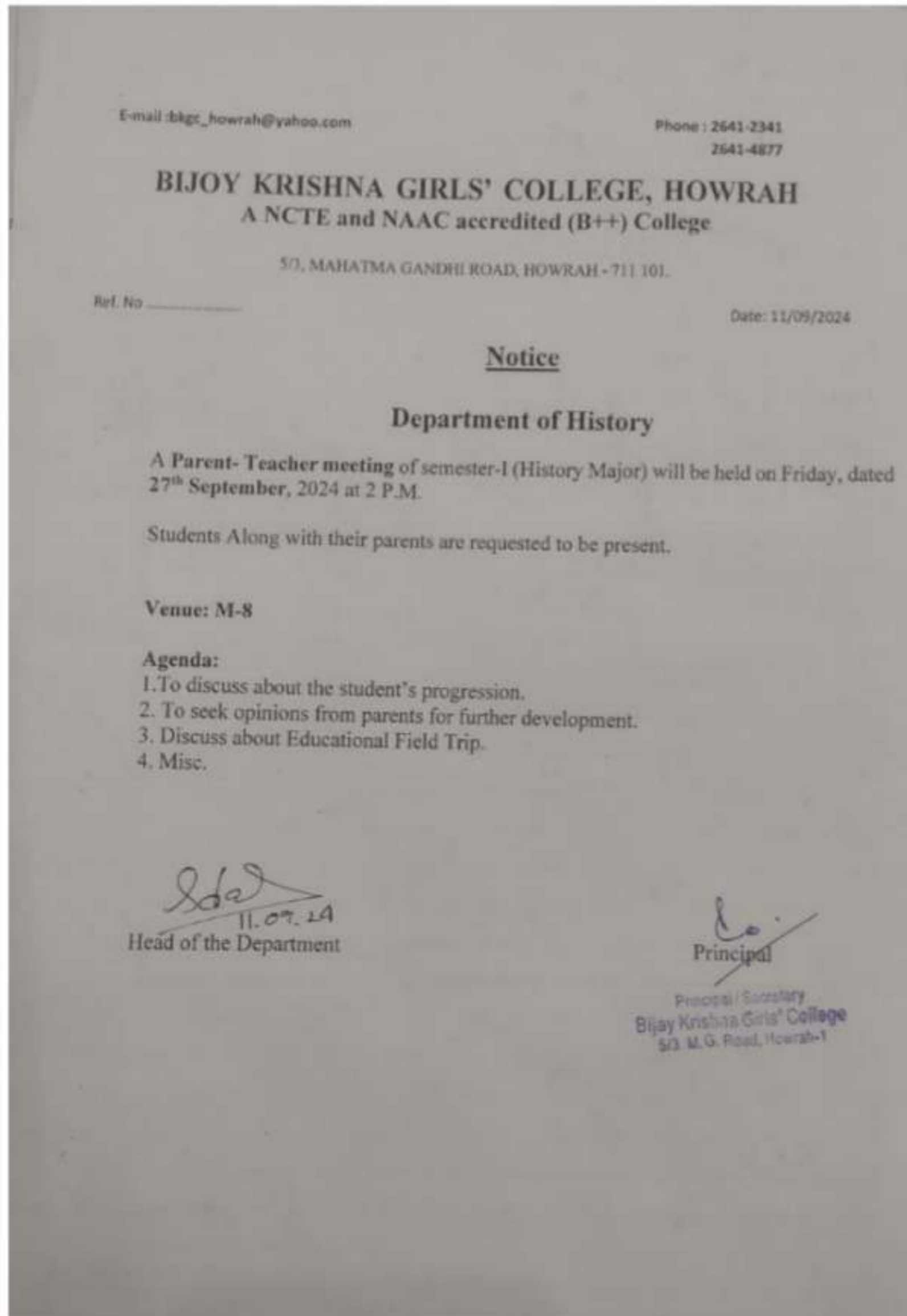

12. Programme Outcome: The Quiz competition encouraged the students to participate and enjoy the programme.

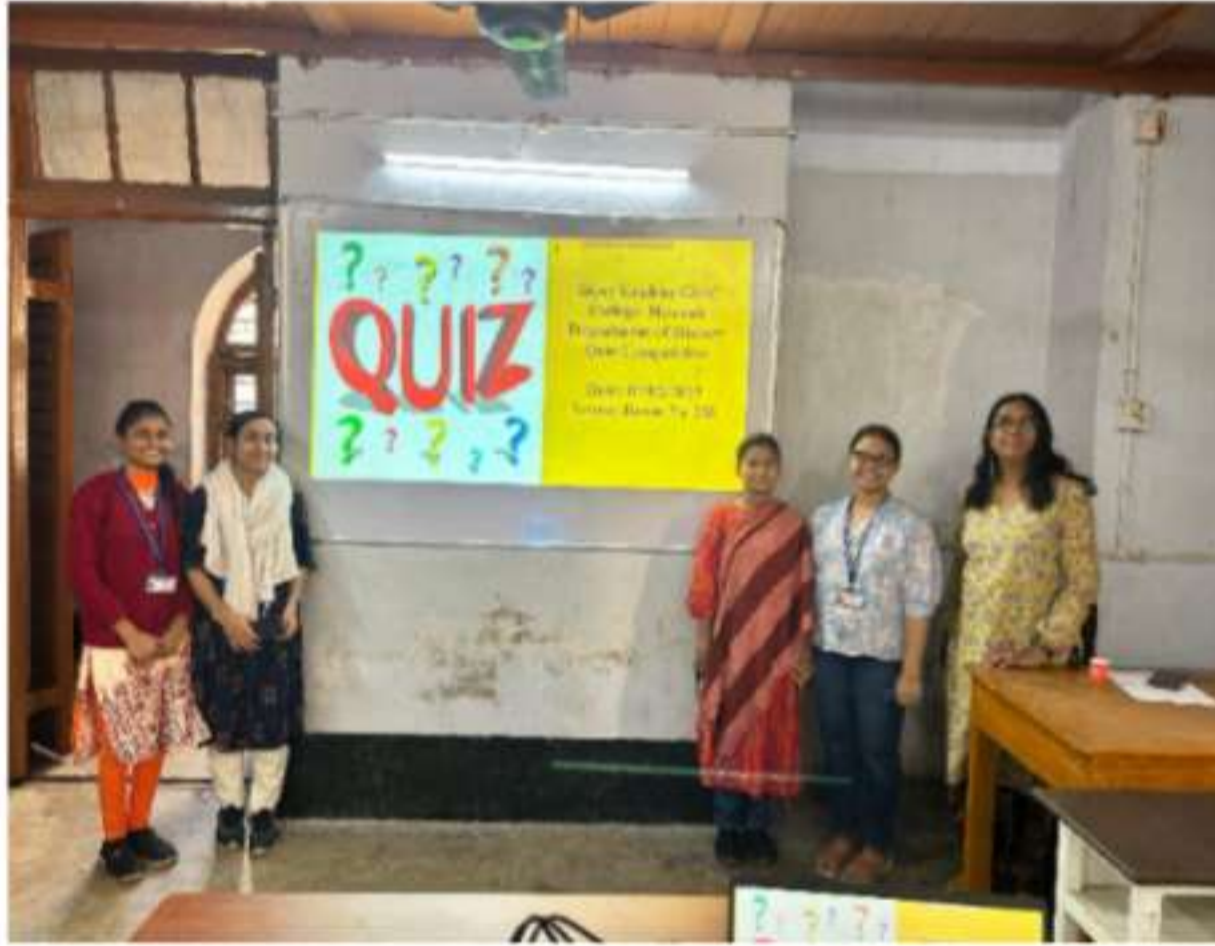

11. Report on the programme: The History Department of Bijoy Krishna Girls' College, Howrah, organised an educational tour to Deulti and Ananda Niketan Kirtishala for the 1st, 3rd, and 5th semester students on 16/12/2024. First we went to Deulti, the residence of novelist Sarat Chandra Chattopadhyay, which lies by the river Rupnarayan. This place is historically important as many revolutionaries had visited and Congress members held discussions when Sarat Chandra was the president. This quaint house is still owned by the family but has been designated as a heritage house by the government. The furniture and objects used by Sarat Chandra are on display. We next went to Ananda Niketan Kirtishala in Bagnan, which is a local museum and houses the Folk Art collection of Tarapada Santra. The artwork on display opened a new horizon for the students in their appreciation of the course on Museums and Archives. Our colleagues expertly organised this educational tour, fostering a stronger sense of camaraderie among the students.

12. Programme Outcome: The students of the BA History Major 1st and 3rd semesters who visited Deulti, the residence of novelist Sarat Chandra Chattopadhyay and Ananda Niketan Kirtishala, wrote a report, which they submitted as a tutorial as part of the Course work for the SEC paper. All the students were impressed by their visit and created a sense of local history amongst students.

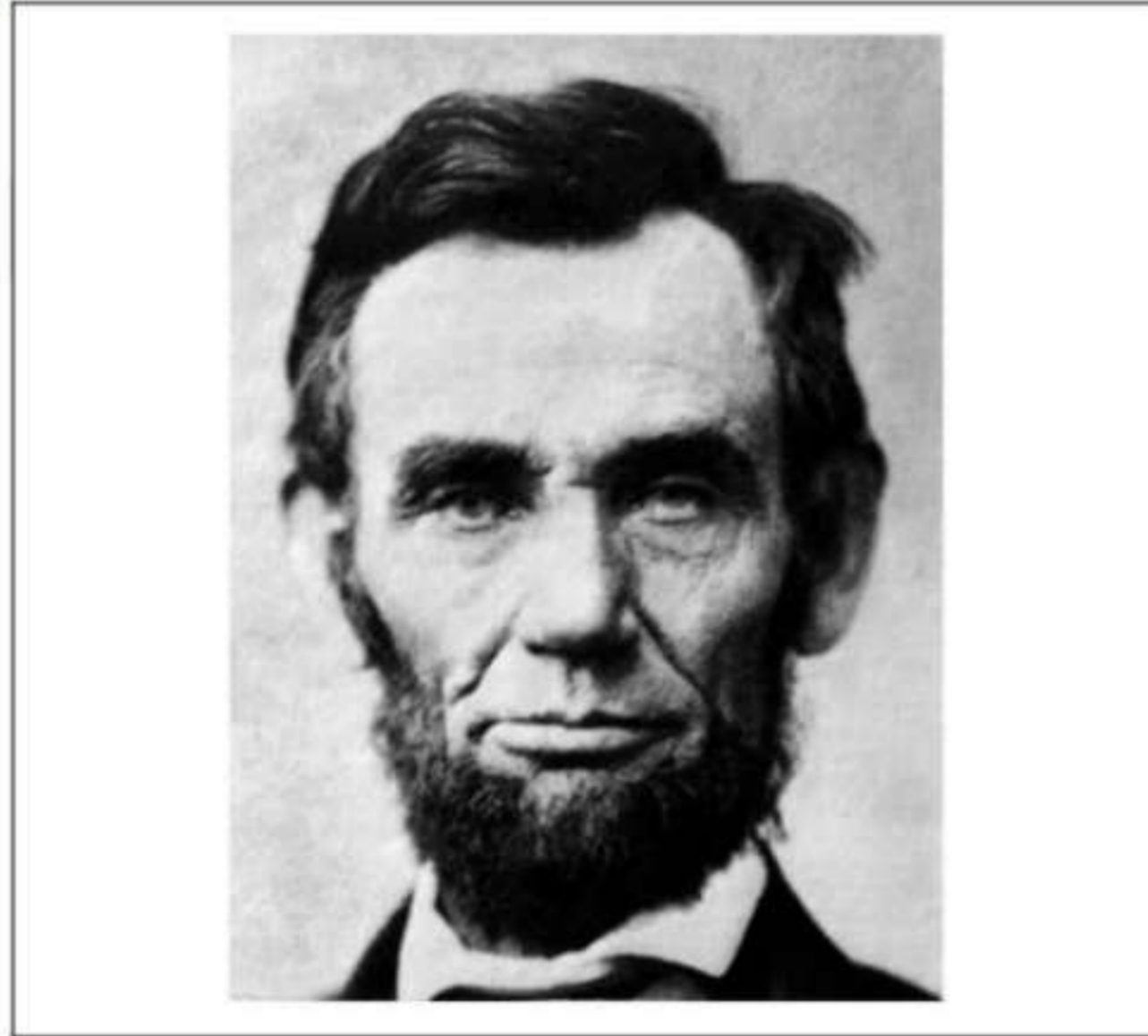
7. Report on the program:

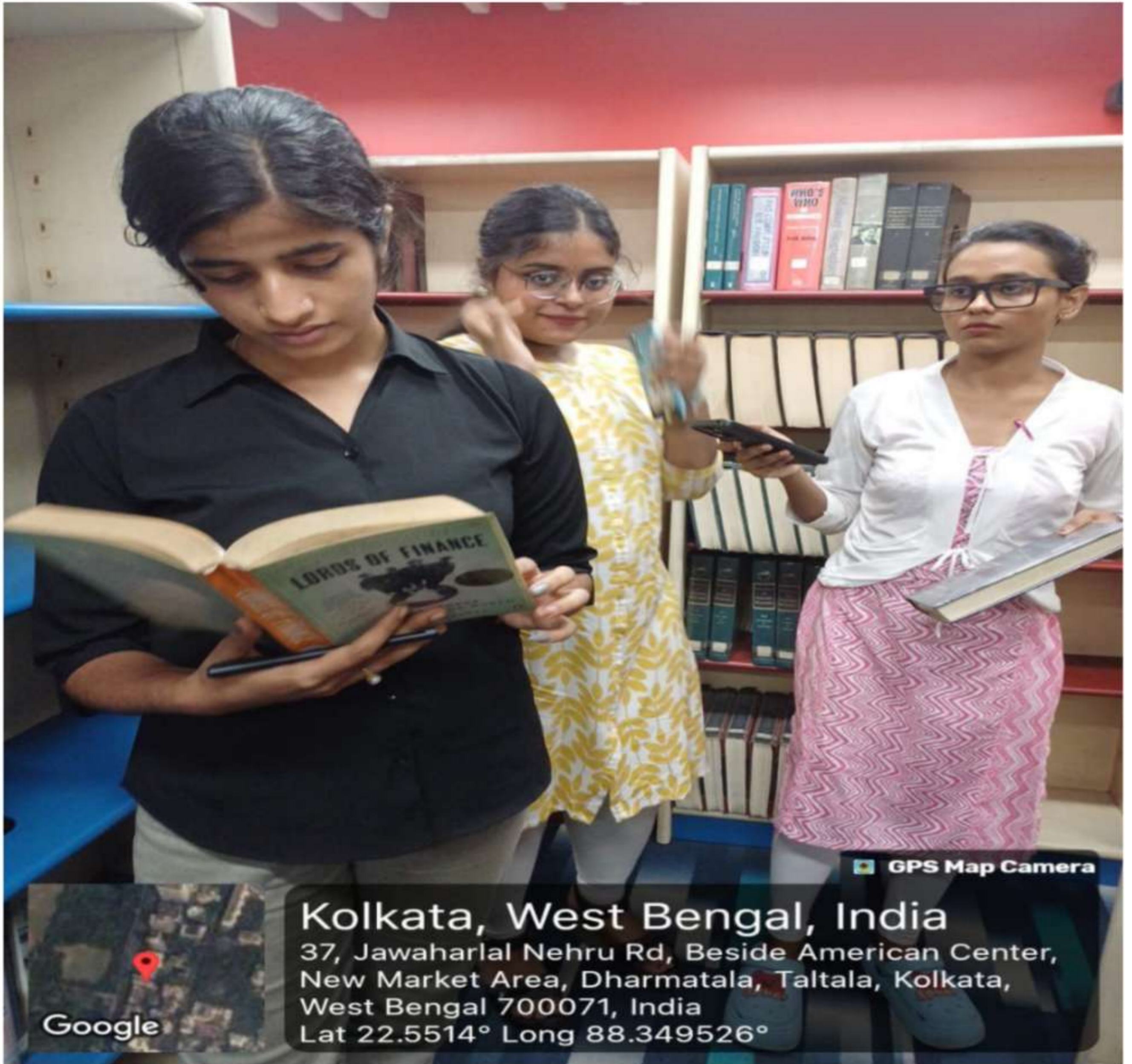

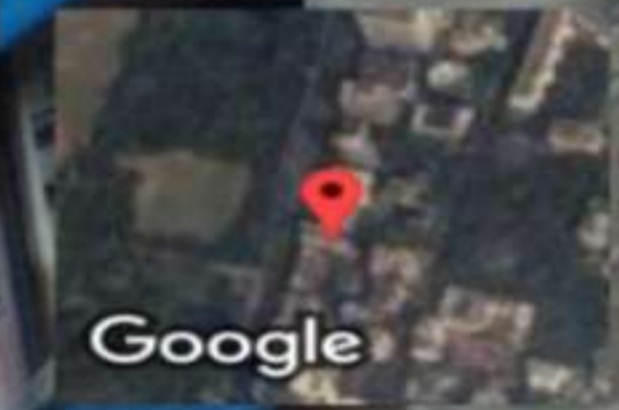

11. Report of the programme:

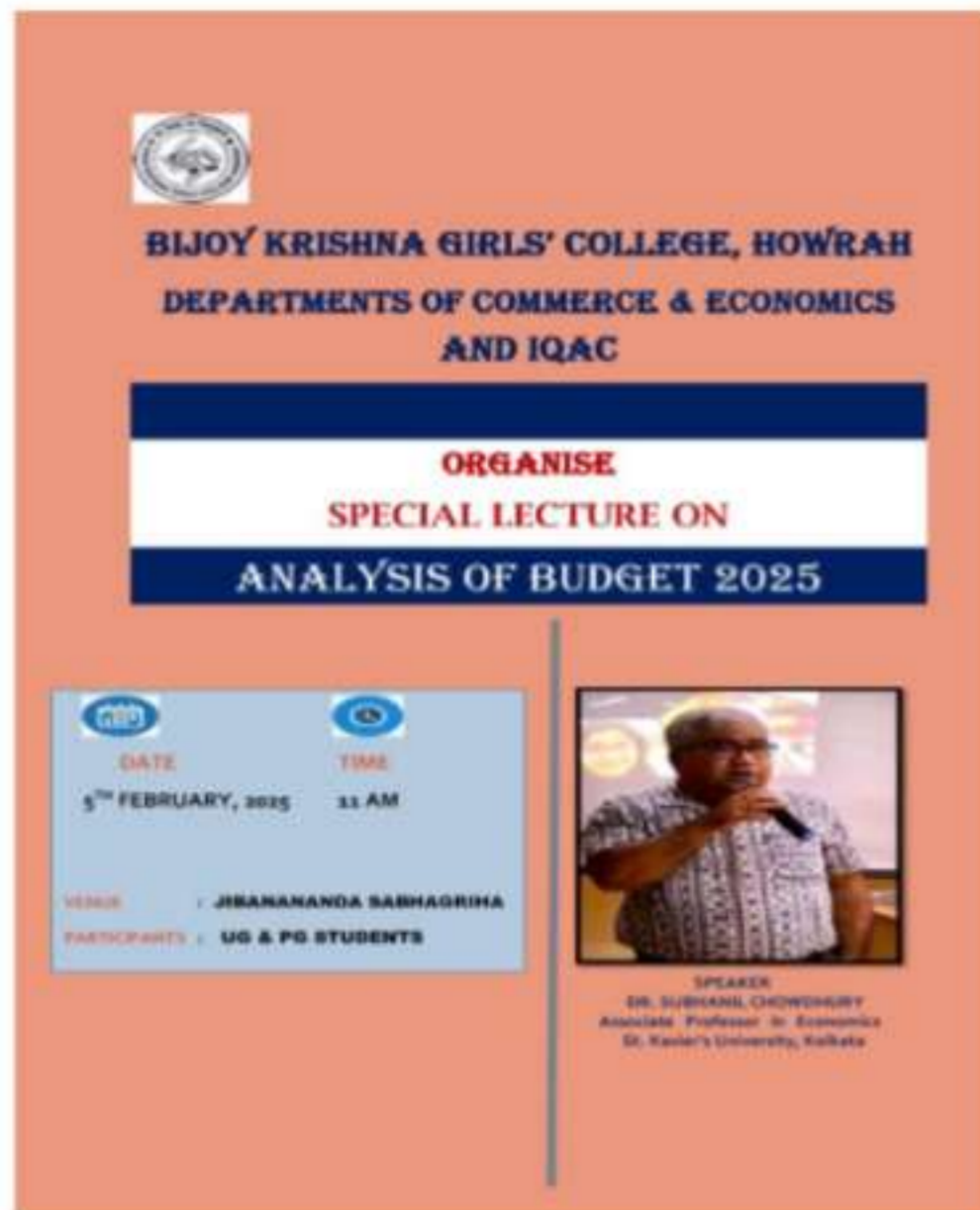
